8. Site History and Description:

Veolia ES Technical Solutions LLC (Transfer Facility) formerly Onyx Environmental Services L.L.C. (VEOLIA) notified the Department of Universal Waste Transfer Area activities for the above parking area within the industrial park at 4972 Woodville Highway, South Lot, Tallahassee on January 9, 2006. This area is used for trailer/van parking for VEOLIA transporter vehicles prior to and after unloading at the Hg Recovery and Reclamation Facility. This location is a Transfer Area and regulations allow parking of the trailer/van in this area for up to 10 days maximum. During the last inspection of VEOLIA, conducted on May 4, 2006, a violation was cited for storing universal waste for greater than 10 days.

9. Site Inspections:

On July 18, 2006, Melissa Woehle and Kathy Gaynor of FDEP inspected VEOLIA for the purpose of a RCRA compliance inspection for the Universal Waste Transfer Area. Ms. Linda Dunwoody provided access to the facilities and descriptions of the processes.

Copies of the "10-Day Material Log" showing arrival dates 5/1/06 thru 7/1/2006 were printed and used as reference for this inspection. A review of the Log indicated manifested material is unloaded on the day of arrival and no trailers arriving within this time frame were allowed to remain loaded for more than 10 days. The database records and "in-coming" trailer folders indicated trailers parked in Dock 1 and Dock 2 at the TSD facility and three trailers parked in the transfer area were awaiting unloading.

A physical inspection of the Transfer Area, confirmed three loaded trailers parked in this area. A visual inspection of the contents of all three trailers was conducted. Photos of the contents of each trailer are copied below.

All three trailers held inbound shipments of Universal Wastes awaiting unloading at the facility. No hazardous waste (manifested or un-manifested) was noted within any of the trailers. There was a fourth trailer parked in this area. Ms. Dunwoody explained that the trailer was empty and not being used. No inspection of this trailer was conducted.
