## NON-COMPLIANCE LETTER

Dear Mr. Gerald:

The purpose of this letter is to advise you of possible violations of law for which you may be responsible, and to seek your cooperation in resolving the matter. A field inspection by Department of Environmental Protection personnel on April 18, 2007of Ring Power Corporation located at 32000 Blue Star Highway, Gadsden County, Florida, indicates that violations of the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) and Chapters 376 and 403, Florida Statutes and Rules may exist at the above-described facility. These possible violations are described in the "Summary of Alleged Violations" section of the enclosed Inspection Report. (All Title 40 Code of Federal Regulations provisions have been adopted by reference in Florida Administrative Code, Chapter 62-730).

The activities observed during the Department's field inspection and any other activities at your facility that may be contributing to violations of the above-described statutes or rules may involve potential liability for civil penalties and should be ceased. Operation of a facility in violation of state statutes or rule may result in liability for damages and restoration as set forth in Section 403.727, Florida Statutes.

Please be advised that this letter is part of an agency investigation preliminary to agency action within the meaning of Section 120.57(5), F.S. We request that you review the alleged violations noted in the enclosed inspection report and respond in writing within 14 days of receipt of this Non-compliance Letter. The Department is interested in reviewing any facts you may have that will assist in determining whether any violations have occurred. Your written response should either describe what you have

done to comply with the "Recommendations" section of the report, or provide evidence to support a claim that the alleged violations did not occur.

It is the Department's intention to allow you to document compliance or corrective actions. Your failure to respond promptly in writing may result in the initiation of formal enforcement proceedings. Follow-up inspections may be conducted to determine compliance with other Department rules and regulations.
