Subject: RCRA inspection of Terminal Services Company.

On Wednesday, August 15, 2007, at 10:11 a.m. EST, I conducted the inspection of the Terminal Services Company (TSC) located at 2778 West Tharpe Street, Tallahassee, FL (Parcel ID 2120204210000) (Latitude 30° 26′ 30″ / Longitude 84° 20′ 14″) in Leon County to ensure compliance with the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.

The facility is now complying with the recommendations noted in February 28, 2007, HazWaste inspection report.

- 1. The facility did a hazardous waste determination on all waste streams as recommended in recommendations (a). The facility did not appear to be generating hazardous waste at the time of my inspection.
- 2. The facility appears to have all used oil and use oil filter containers properly labeled, closed and stored as recommended in recommendations (c).
- 3. TSC is keeping all disposal receipts on site as recommended in (d).
- 4. TSC has assessed, removed and analyzed all contaminated soils identified and has sent the Department the results as recommended in (e).
- 5. TSC has made a hazardous waste determination on all of the drums located by the washing facility. The analysis was sent to the Department as recommended in (f).
- 6. All waste lamps are now managed in accordance to 40 CFR 273.13(d), 273.14 & 273.15(c) as recommended in (g).
- 7. I did not see any chlorinated solvents during my inspection. Mr. Wier stated that the facility no longer uses any chlorinated solvents as recommended in (h).

The facility appears to be in compliance with the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act.
