8. FACILITY DESCRIPTION:

Bay Line Railroad (BL) is registered with the department as a transporter of hazardous waste by rail. BL was last inspected on 26 July 1999.

BL transports waste terpene burn fuel from Arizona Chemical Co to Systech Environmental's facility in Paulding, Ohio (OHD005048947). This waste is transported on BL's trackage to Dothan, Alabama (81 miles) before switching to another carrier. Nineteen manifests covering the period 14 July 1999 to 10 March 2000 were reviewed. BL transported 438,732 gallons of terpene waste during that period.

BL meets the requirements to be a transporter of hazardous waste in the State of Florida.
