Dear Mr. Wier:

This letter is in regards to the Drum Cleanup Project at the McKenzie Tank Lines Inc., (COM_68413) located at 2778 West Tharpe Street, Tallahassee, Leon County, Florida.

Upon review of the February 25, 2008 Interim Source Removal report (ISRR) Addendum, it appears that no impacted soils remain in the East Drum Accumulation Area. It was this area that Florida Department of Environmental Protection and Region IV Environmental Protection Agency personnel discovered several 55-gallon drums of material improperly stored with evidence of spilled material in a site inspection conducted in February 2007.

However, during the assessment, your consultant has identified impacted soils in the north, northwest portion of the site in areas where additional drums had been stored. This area has been identified as the Washrack Drum/West Drum Accumulation/Drums West/Drum 76 Area on the site map included in the February 25, 2008 ISRR Addendum; a copy of map is enclosed. Since this area is located approximately 200 feet west of the East Drum Accumulation Area and the impacted soils were not discovered until later on in the assessment prompted by the site inspection, it has been determined that these two areas are to be considered separate and independent cleanup projects by the Department. Therefore, each project will be required to meet the criteria of Chapter 62-780, Florida Administrative Code.

Upon review of the information submitted to date, it appears that the East Drum Accumulation Area cleanup project (FDEP COM_312177) may meet the No Further Action (NFA) criteria of Rule 62-780.680, F.A.C. An NFA Proposal regarding the East Drum Accumulation Area project should be submitted to the FDEP Northwest District Cleanup Section for review. The groundwater analytical and sampling logs for the resampling of well MW-2D requested in our March 27, 2008 letter should be included in the proposal.

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Furthermore, a complete site assessment should commence in the West Drum Accumulation Area (FDEP COM_312175) and a site assessment report (SAR) meeting the criteria of Rule 62-780.600, F.A.C will need to be submitted to the FDEP Northwest District Cleanup Section for review.

Unless notified otherwise, we look forward to receiving your NFA Proposal for the East Drum Accumulation Area cleanup project by June 30, 2008 and a SAR for the West Drum Accumulation Area no later than December 31, 2008. 
