Clean Harbors Florida LLC. (CHF) is resubmitting this request for the purpose of revision/updating of the facility's Waste Analysis Plan as a minor modification (Not otherwise listed) as defined under FAC 62-730.290(4) and as a Class 1 permit modification as reflected under B.1.a. in Appendix I to 40 CFR 270.42.

None of the plan's substantive conditions are being changed. The only change is to page three of Chapt 2A Appx H (WAP) of the permit application and page 33 of 33 of the issued permit. (Attached). Please replace existing pages with these upon approval. The revision is necessary to ensure compliance with security access and control of Rx Drugs managed on site under the regulations, guidance and permitting rules found under FAC 64F-12.013 by exempting it from the WAP required sampling and testing onsite and to identity the storage location of UW Pharm on site.

CLASS ONE MODIFICATION SUMMARY

- Change facility WAP to reflect UW Pharm exempt from testing.
 In order to manage UW Pharm on site we will require certification of inventory prior to acceptance. To comply with internal safety requirements and minimize any unauthorized access to such sensitive materials we will forbid / prohibit onsite access. Current Waste Analysis Plan requires sampling of incoming materials for conformance testing and in order to ensure we can implement the access restriction we need to specifically exempt this material from being opened on site.
- Change permitted roll off figure in permit issued.
 The storage of UW Pharm (also known as "non viable Rx Drugs" under DOH regulations), requires secured storage with restricted access. In order to comply with the security and access requirements we will use a sealed "storage unit" know also as a "conex or sea container" which can be locked and access to it monitored and controlled. When storage of this material is required, the unit will occupy and be located in one of our RCRA permitted storage locations for our roll offs. We have numbered our locations on the revised facility plot to make identification and reference convenient.

Number one roll off storage area will be "interchangeable" with this UW Pharm storage unit. Meaning the area designated as roll off storage area number one will either be used for RCRA roll off storage as currently permitted or UW Pharm material storage, not both, hence there will be no increase in any waste storage volume on site. The RCRA roll off storage area numbered one is currently permitted for up to 40 cubic yards of RCRA solid waste. The UW Pharm storage unit is physically smaller and in no way will exceed capacity currently permitted for RCRA solid waste in that location.

Containers of Universal Waste Pharmaceuticals received under our DOH Rx Restricted Prescription

Drug Distributor – Destruction License will not be opened or sampled due to security access concerns.

Content certification made by generator as required by DOH will be confirmed at final disposal facility.

2.3.2 Lab Pack and Paint Can Procedures

CHF also receives lab pack wastes and small cans of wastes (such as paint cans). The primary use of these wastes is for fuels. However should the waste not meet fuels specifications it will be reclaimed or shipped to an off-site permitted TSDF. This waste is shipped to CHF in small containers (ampoules to 5 gallon) inside larger containers. These wastes may be consolidated from the small containers into larger containers (typically 55 gallon drums). After the waste has been emptied into the larger container it is then sampled and analyzed.

The quality control procedure for a lab pack begins when the materials are packaged for shipment. Clean Harbors chemists who provide the packaging service are trained to follow the guidelines for lab packs. Each container is examined and the label verified prior to packaging. A packing list is prepared identifying the contents of every container packaged in the lab pack. CHF requires a packing list to be provided for each lab pack before the lab pack is received.

For the lab packs not packaged by Clean Harbors personnel, 10% of the lab packs are opened and the contents compared to the packing list to identify any discrepancies in quantity or identity. Should the contents in the container not match the description of same on the packing list, the discrepancy will be resolved with the generator or the lab pack could be rejected.

For small cans, as described in Chapter One, a packing list is not included. CHF, therefore, will sample a portion of these containers to verify the contents before they are emptied into a receiving drum. These waste streams are very consistent waste streams, so each container will not need sampling. The sampling procedures for sampling paint cans are given in Section 2.5.3.3.

2.3.3 In-Processing of Tank Trucks and Roll-offs

Documentation of the waste sample is initiated after a tanker is sampled. An internal process form is used to document this for all wastes received. An example of this form is presented in Figure 2.2. The sampling procedures for sampling these large bulk shipments are given in Section 2.5.3.2.






