THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (FDEP) is proposing to issue a PERMIT UNDER SECTION 403.12(1), FLORIDA STATUTES (F.S.), AND 62B-01, FLORIDA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE (F.A.C.), TO PERMA-FIX OF DR. LANDO, INC. The permit is for the construction, operation, and maintenance of a hazardous waste management unit (HWMU) located at 22824 facility road, number 22824, in the City of Orlando, Orange County, Florida. The proposed remedial actions for all solid waste management units are no further action.

Copies of the application and the draft permit are available for public inspection at the FDEP's regional office, 1201 E. 17th Avenue, Suite 200, Orlando, Florida 32803. The permit is subject to a public hearing on November 24, 2008, at 10:00 a.m. in the FDEP's regional office. The hearing is open to the public and interested parties. The hearing is being held to provide an opportunity for the public to comment on the proposed permit. A person whose substantial interest in or who will be adversely affected by the proposed permit may petition for an administrative determination (hereinafter referred to as a "petition") under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. The petition must be filed with the FDEP's regional office, 1201 E. 17th Avenue, Suite 200, Orlando, Florida 32803, within 45 days of the date of the public hearing. A petition that disputes the material facts on which FDEP's action is based must contain the following information:
(a) The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner; the applicant's FDEP Permit File Number and the county in which the project is proposed;
(b) A statement of how and why the petitioner's interest in the project is affected by FDEP's proposed action; (c) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interest in the project is affected by FDEP's proposed action; (d) A statement of all material facts disputed by petitioner, or a statement that there are no disputed facts; (e) A statement of facts which petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of FDEP's proposed action; (f) A statement of petitioner's proposed action; and (g) A statement of the petitioner's proposed action to take with respect to the proposed action.

A petition that does not dispute the material facts on which FDEP's action is based shall state that no such dispute exists and shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301, F.A.C. Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that the petitioner is taking the case to the next level. The petitioner is not entitled to a hearing on the petition taken by it in this notice. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by FDEP's action shall file a petition with the FDEP's regional office, 1201 E. 17th Avenue, Suite 200, Orlando, Florida 32803, within 45 days of the date of the public hearing. Failure to file a request for a public hearing within this time period shall constitute a waiver of the right to request a hearing under Section 403.12(1)(f), F.S.

Any person may request a public hearing regarding the proposed permit under Section 403.12(1)(f), F.S. A request for a public hearing is not equivalent to a request for a formal or informal administrative hearing. Public hearings are not evidentiary in nature, and information submitted at a public hearing is for non-binding purposes only. A public hearing is not subject to court or appellate review. A request for a public hearing must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel, 1201 E. 17th Avenue, Suite 200, Orlando, Florida 32803, within 45 days of publication of this notice. Failure to file a request for a public hearing within this time period shall constitute a waiver of the right to request a hearing under Section 403.12(1)(f), F.S.

Mediation is not available in this proceeding.


