The purpose of this letter is to advise you of possible violations of law for which you may be responsible and to seek your cooperation in resolving the matter. Hazardous waste program compliance inspections were conducted on August 6, 2007, and on November 7, 2008, which indicate that violations of Florida Statutes and Rules may exist at your facility. Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) personnel made observations described in the attached inspection report.
