A meeting was held on March 19, 2009 in Tallahassee. Lu and I teleconferenced in for the meeting. Those attending were:

The meeting was held in order to discuss the permit conditions for new permit at Sanford and discuss the open CD enforcement case. FDEP opened the meeting by suggesting that if language could be agreed upon in the new permit, the current enforcement case will be closed. During the meeting, FDEP suggested new language be added to the permit concerning CUP. SK stated they did not feel they needed to have any info about CUP in the permit. FDEP requested a statement outlining the concentration of contaminants that should not be in CUP solvent. SK was not comfortable with listing any quantitative limits in the permit. SK suggested their parts washer waste would fail TCLP for lead. FDEP pointed out that the analytical results of waste solvent did not show elevated levels of lead. The meeting lasted 2.5 hours and SK agreed to provide new draft language for the permit, provide the specifications for the solvent and conduct sampling at the Tampa facility in order to determine their annual re-characterization of their waste codes on the parts washer waste. SK requested that the violations from the enforcement case be removed from EPA ECHO database. FDEP will look into it but we have no control over EPAs database.
