GENERAL COMMENTS

2. The purpose of combining Solid Waste (SW) permit with Used Oil (UO) permit is that the company would be bringing in SW that would be associated with Oily waste such as petroleum contaminated waste and absorbents to a limited capacity. This does not appear to be the case with the CBI, Inc. Tampa, UO processing facility. Please clarify and address the following point which you mentioned in your April 3, 2009 response submittal as part of the solid waste proposed permitting activities:

d. Specify the solidifying agent and be specific.

"The facility indicated that the solid waste will be blended and then mixed to produce a solid waste appropriate for land filling". This is not acceptable. The facility must specify what material you will be using to mix with the solid waste, for example: wood chips, saw dust, or mulch. The Facility cannot be using fly ash or another solid waste.

Please review, revise and resubmit the paragraph.

Additional Comment:

Also, the Department would like to inspect the "pit" (chamber), after it has been cleaned out, but before the epoxy is put down. Please let us know the schedule of planned activities at least seven (7) days before the event, so that the department can plan to visit the facility.
