Introduction:

Everglades Waste Removal Services (EWRS) is located on approximately 3.5 acres, employs 6 and has been in operation for two years. The facility consists of a parking lot where empty trucks are parked and a maintenance shop where trucks are serviced. Also in the maintenance area are privately-owned auto restoration projects, and race car repair projects belonging to the owner and his son.

Process Description:

Two aqueous parts washers were observed in the shop areas. The parts washers generated approximately 1 quart of sludge per month which was mixed with the used oil. The shop generated used oil, oil filters, and used antifreeze. Used oil and filters were removed by Cliff Berry, Inc. Used antifreeze was reused in their equipment.

Currently, EWRS is transporting oily water generated in bilges, but plans to start transporting used oil and filters from future clients.

Outside in the truck parking area, there was a pallet of rusted paint cans and thinner containers. Inspectors directed EWRS employees to move the pallet inside and perform a waste determination for proper disposal of unusable material.
