Emergency Response Plan:

This Emergency Response Plan is not all inclusive, but designed to provide a guide for appropriate actions in the event of a spill. The most important thing to remember is to remain calm and try to get the situation under control as soon as possible.

- A. DO NOT PANIC, REMAIN CALM. Examine your own condition first. If you or anyone with you is injured, call for medical assistance.
- B. Assess the extent of rupture or damage to the tank or hoses. CLOSE OFF any valves, hatches or hose connections; secure out flow.
- C. Evaluate the degree of contamination to the environment and estimate the number of gallons spilled.
- D. If possible, pump liquid back into the tank, even if the is ruptured. This will recycle the spilled oil to the truck's tank rather tan spreading it onto the ground.
- E. Do your best to dike ahead of the spill to prevent oil from entering storm sewers and/or waterways.

Oil Spill Reporting Requirements:

- 1. Name, address and phone of person reporting the incident
- 2. Exact location of the spill
- 3. Date & time the spill occurred
- 4. Name of material spilled (if other than oil)
- 5. Estimated quantity spilled
- 6. Source of spilled material
- 7. Cause of spill (if known)
- 8. Containment & clean-up actions taken
