This letter is in response to a telephone conversation with Pasco County Governments Special Services concerning the referenced site. It appears that Perma-Fix of Orlando made an administrative error on the manifest without following proper procedures to correct the error. The transporter copy of the manifest was corrected but the generator's copy was not. The drum that was picked up from the referenced site was a 30-gallon not a 55 gallon drum. An empty 55-gallon drum was dropped off.

Perma-fix of Orlando apologizes for this error and has reinforced to the employees the procedures that are in place so that this does not occur again.
