I feel as if I am failing considerably on the SEP Project. I have done everything short of begging Contractors to start the permitting and construction process. The last Contractor, Matthews & Hannah verbally committed and was to be moving forward with the Civil Engineer & permitting. They have failed to return my calls for the past three weeks.

I also faxed the rough plans to several local contractors only to get the reply that they were overly busy or the project was beneath their scope of work.

On the bright side.., I meet with Atlas Buildings of Kissimmee a couple of weeks ago and again yesterday morning. The owner Gary Dotson is scheduled to be in today for a look at the site. Their building is a pre-fab corrugated metal building that assembles in a very short amount of time. He has said that I will have to do the permit, but he will assist. Also, due to the fact that the slab is pre-existing he feels that permitting should be simplified.

The positive aspect to Atlas is that this Project (< \$ 100,000.00) is a Major project for their company verses the contractors I've worked with to date.
