Dear Mr. Waechter:

On April 13, 2005, Perma-Fix signed a Consent Order entering into an agreement with the Department. The purpose of the Consent Order was to complete the resolution of matters previously identified by the Department in the Warning Letter, OWL-HW-C/E-04-025, dated August 12, 2004. The Department agreed to allow Perma-Fix to offset penalties from that enforcement action by implementing a Supplement Environmental Project (SEP). The SEP included the construction of a Consolidation and Building with monthly updates, due the first of each month, describing the progress of the construction and 24 hour notification of any delays in completing the construction. The Consent Order stated a signed contract from construction contractor was to be submitted to the Department by June 1, 2005.

As of August 4, 2005 the contract has not been received by the Department and according to email correspondence, no contract for construction has been signed as of this mailing. The Department will allow an extension of the deadline for the contract to be submitted until August 31. If Perma-Fix fails to implement the SEP as approved, the SEP option shall be forfeited and any balance of the civil penalty due within 10 days of notification by the Department to Perma-Fix that the balance is due and owing.
