**Process Description:**

The Veolia Transfer Yard (Veolia) is used for the storage of facility transport trailers. Seven trailers were randomly inspected to ensure compliance with state and federal regulations. The trailers had different items stored on them and all matched the transfer yard log records that are maintained by Veolia. The storage times vary depending on the content of the trailers. Trailers that have universal waste stored on them are kept in the transfer yard for a maximum of ten days. On the tenth day or previous to that day the universal waste is off-loaded at the main facility's docking area for processing.

Veolia is proposing to move its transfer facility from its current location (non-contiguous with the reclamation facility) to an area that is located on the other side of Marpan Lane (near the reclamation facility). The reason for the relocation of the transfer yard is due to the land owner wanting to use the current transfer yard land area for other commercial buildings. Veolia will submit its proposal to the Department when it is prepared to move the transfer yard.
