Subject: Closure of out-of-service tanks.

Mr. Berman:

Your e-mail of July 26, 2010 asked for clarification on the possibility of closing and removing two RCRA permitted tanks and retaining their permitted capacity until such time, if any, when business conditions support their replacement.

The Department is willing to allow for the proper removal of the tanks, provided all applicable rules and regulations are followed for closure and removal. The permitted capacity of these tanks will be retained for future use. The permitted capacity of these tanks shall not be utilized until such time as replacement tanks have been installed, certified by a professional engineer registered in the State of Florida, and accepted for use by the Department.

These actions will be accomplished by modifying your hazardous waste operating permit. The replacement of a hazardous waste tank with a tank of similar composition and volume is a Class 1 modification as defined in 40 Code of Federal Regulations 270.42(a), with the minor modification fee specified by 62-730.293(1)(u), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). In this specific instance, since there will be an indefinite period of time between removal and replacement, the permit will need to be modified twice; once when the tanks are removed and once when the tanks are replaced.

The replacement of the tanks should not enact the provisions of 62-730.182, F.A.C., provided the volume of the replacement tanks is not greater than the current permitted capacity of the tanks being removed, and no additional waste codes are associated with the tanks.

Removal of these tanks will not preclude the requirements for future closure of the facility in the vicinity of these tanks and the taking of soil and groundwater samples to determine the presence or absence of contamination.
