We understand that Florida Department of Environmental Protection requires proof of liability insurance, or other means of financial responsibility, for renewal of the above referenced application.

Please let this letter serve as evidence that JEA is self-insured for public liability insurance, including automobile liability. As a municipality, JEA has a limitation of liability in tort actions of \$100,000 per person, \$200,000 per occurrence, in accordance with Section 768.28, Florida Statute, Negligence.

JEA agrees to be financially responsible for sudden and accidental occurrences involving bodily injury and property damage which may be incurred in the transport of used oil for the required minimum amount of \$100,000 combined single limit. Enclosed is JEA's current annual report for period ending September 30, 2009, demonstrating JEA's financial ability to pay self-insured public liability claims.
