Hello everyone: FYI, we have received the facilities response dated 3/30/04 today, since we had a meeting on 3/16/04 in Tallahassee.

According to facility's letter Alternate methods 2 (added metal rods) and 3 (perforated center pipe will be completed by May 15, 2004 and with formal results reported by May 28, 2004. Following the completion of methods 2 and 3, Onyx will conduct several test runs with added data logging thermocoupler in an effort to diagnose the problem encountered prior AM 1 tests. After this diagnoses period, Onyx will submit a report detailing the results of the diagnosis and the time period necessary to complete alternate method 1.

FYI, it appears that it is going to take long time and it may be October 27, 2004 and facility was submitted their Variance Extension Application on October 27, 2003 and almost more than 5 months.
