Dear Elmer Lynam ,

According to Department records, the most recent notification of Hazardous Waste Transporter (HWT) activities we have on file for your facility is dated 09-25-2009. Pursuant to Rules 62-730.170(2)(e) and (3), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.) notification as a HWT must be renewed annually by submitting two originally signed Transporter Status Forms and proof of financial responsibility.

Since the Department did not receive the required documentation for your facility, your registration expired on Aug 6, 2010. Transporting hazardous waste without proper notification to the Department is a violation of the law, subject to penalty.

This letter is to inform you that effective immediately you are no longer authorized to transport hazardous waste from this location in the State of Florida.
