Guidelines

General Requirements

Due to the potential for the presence of regulated hazardous substances, the first step should be to contact the state regulatory agency for a determination, in writing, that the materials collected are not regulated under the hazardous waste rules. It should be made clear to the state that the source of these materials is households only. If received, all collected materials can be delivered to a Covanta facility. However, this does not include regulated medical wastes (e.g. sharps) or materials containing mercury.

If a non-hazardous determination is not received from the state regulatory agency, the regulated hazardous materials must be separated as they cannot be accepted at a Covanta facility.

Packaging

Materials must be packaged in combustible containers such as cardboard boxes or fiber drums. Not steel drums will be accepted. The container weight should be limited to 50 pounds.

Delivery

The facility will be contacted to schedule a delivery. Due to the potential presence of controlled substances, each delivery will be accompanied by a witness. The attached forms must also be filled out and presented to the facility at the time of the delivery.

Destruction

Destruction will be by direct hopper feed or modified grapple feed only. The witness shall remain at the facility until all the material has been fed into the boiler.
