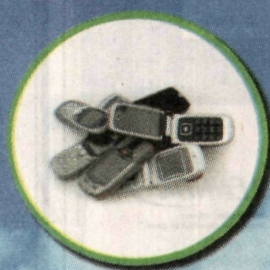

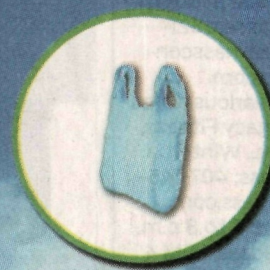
MEDICINE CABINET™

Operation Medicine Cabinet is a free pharmaceutical take-back program that allows residents to dispose of unwanted prescription and over-the-counter medications. This free event aims to reduce youth accessibility to dangerous substances and keep medications and other items out of the waste stream.
