Position Summary:

This position operates various over the road and tractor trailer vehicles according to company safety procedures, transporting cargo to and from destinations within a specified time frame. This includes but is not limited to the transportation of solid and liquid waste material in accordance with EPA guidelines and DOT laws. This position works with established SOP's (Standard Operating Procedures) with specific safety and environmental policies as stated by the Transportation Manager, Plant Manager, EH&S and Branch Manager.

Business Impact:

This position works under general supervision and is guided by clear, standardized practice and procedures.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Deliver excellent customer SERVICE to internal and external customers consistent with FCC's Commitments: Selfless, Ethical, Respectful, Versatile, Innovative, Communication and Encouraging
- Performs day to day operational activities of transporting cargo to and from destinations within a specified time frame.
- Samples and/or test materials either on customer sites or via lab.
- Maintain vehicles and equipment and coordinate maintenance and repairs with the Transportation Manager
- Complete paperwork for safe and legal transportation
- Obtain and maintain a Class A CDL with HAZ-MAT and Tanker Endorsement
- Other duties as assigned

Education/Experience/Qualifications:

High school diploma or equivalent is required. Requires valid Class A CDL with applicable endorsements and a good driving record, knowledge of vehicle maintenance and repair, demonstrated ability to operate CMV Equipment and to meet DOT required physical & drug screen.

Skills, Knowledge and Abilities:

- Ability to read and understand established procedures, including the Waste Analysis Plan and RCRA requirements
- Ability to read and write handwritten and typed correspondence
- Able to work independently and as part of a team
- Effective communication, both oral & written



• Ability to perform and understand mathematical equations (commensurate with job)

Physical Demands:

The physical demands below are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this position.

- Able to climb on top of tank trucks, storage tanks, etc using ladders, hand rails, etc. Involves twisting, turning, pushing and pulling.
- Lift and carry 30-50 pounds on regular basis; move heavier objects (manhole covers, grates, drums, etc.) less frequrently
- Ability to lift/pull hoses (30 –50 lb) while climbing on/off tanks
- Work outdoors in inclement weather
