DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF EMERGENCY COORDINATOR

When there is an imminent or actual emergency situation, the emergency coordinator must immediately:

- 1. Activate communication systems where applicable to notify site personnel;
- Notify local emergency response agencies.

Whenever there is an emission, discharge, fire, or explosion, the emergency coordinator must immediately identify the character, exact source, amount and extent of emitted or discharged materials. He may do this observation or review of records and, if necessary, by chemical analysis.
