7. Discrepancies with Part A Application; Process Description

(Include waste streams by EPA number and listing description, and quantity generated per month.) M & W Southeastern, formerly M & W Industrial Coatings, Incorporated, is in the business of cleaning and/or repairing industrial grade tanks used for the storage of fuel and lubricating oils, gasoline, kerosine and toll oil. The company also contracts its services out for the repair and construction pipelines. M & W tank cleaning operations involve the use of water and a chemical detergent. The rinsate from these operations is analyzed for EP toxicity and ignitability, by TSI of Jacksonville, prior to being removed from the operational site by M & W. Rinsate determined to be nonhazardous is landfilled locally; that which is hazardous is transported to a permitted hazardous waste landfill for disposal. The top ends of the rinsate are given to the City's Hazardous Material Team for use in training exercises. M & W has not transported hazardous waste since the previous inspection April 11, 1983. No further action is necessary.
