Introduction:

On February 7, 2011, Danielle Bentzen and Danielle Owens, Florida Department of Environmental Protection (DEP), inspected Shaw Environmental (Shaw) for compliance with state and federal hazardous waste and used oil regulations. Gregory Dever accompanied inspectors through the facility. Shaw is registered with the Department as a hazardous waste transporter.

This is a district office that Shaw operates in a 10,000 square foot building for offices and warehouse, 2,300 sq ft is used as warehouse space. Only environmental consulting is done out of this location.

Inspection History

On December 3, 2009, the Department inspected Shaw as a hazardous waste transporter and the facility was in compliance.

Process Description:

Shaw is registered as a hazardous waste transporter for the sole purpose of emergency response. Per Shaw's lease agreement, no waste is to be stored on site. Hazardous waste is transported directly from the generation site to a treatment, storage, and disposal facility. Training records were received, via email on April 27, 2011, and reviewed for the drivers and found to be in compliance.

As a reminder, Shaw is required to keep a copy of all records pertaining to this EPA Identification number on site for review. This would include manifests, training records, and contingency plan.
