The enclosed Hazardous Waste Manifest is provided as closure to an incident I brought to your attention on February 13, 2002 in which a 55-gallon drum of antifreeze reclamation sludge was discovered at TEC's Central Operations Center, labeled with an exceeded 90-day accumulation date.

Clark Environmental – Hazardous Waste Division, picked up this drum on February 21, 2002 and transported it to Southeastern Chemical & Solvent located in Sumter, South Carolina for stabilization prior to landfill. The facility signed the manifest on March 3, 2002, verifying receipt. To prevent this type of violation from reoccurring, an on-site Coordinator has been appointed to manage all waste streams generated at the Central Operations Center. 
