Thank you for your correspondence of November 10, 2011. CBI offers the following reply for your consideration:

1. **HAZARDOUS WASTE TRANSFER FACILITY LOCATION:** The area noted in the plans for the temporary storage of hazardous waste is being cleared and materials returned to this approved location. Returning to the original area eliminates the distance issue to the nearest public roadway and eliminates the need to modify the permit or submit documentation per 62-730.171(3)(b) F.A. C.. Segregation using berms is being addressed as part of a review of the space for improvements.
2. **PART V – NON-HAZARDOUS, NON-USED OIL WASTE CONDITIONS:** CBI agrees with reviewing the wording of the permit to allow the bulking of non-hazardous, non-used oil wastes from any source.
3. **BIO-FUELS:** A write-up of the pilot scale bio-fuels study is being internally reviewed and is forthcoming. Please advise as to the next steps in formalizing the process if we wish to consider full-scale production.

Thank you again for your attention to detail in review of the facility and I look forward to discussing these matters further at your convenience.
