Dear Mr. Benyon:

Unocal has reviewed the Consent Order Modification (OGC Case No. 84-0762) drafted by the Department.

Unocal is prepared to sign the Consent Order Modification with the following changes:

1). Paragraph 24 should read:

Within 90 days of notification from the Department that remediation has begun at Floval, respondent shall submit a Remediation Assessment Plan pursuant to paragraphs 17 through 24 of the attached Exhibit II, "Corrective Actions for Groundwater Contamination". Unocal shall have access to all reports, data, plans and other information concerning the Floval site submitted to the Department or County by Floval, its contractors or anyone; or prepared by or for the Department or County excepting any such information the release of which is prohibited by law.

2). Paragraph 25 should be deleted.


Unocal has repeatedly expressed its willingness to begin any necessary remediation activities once the upgradient (Floval) contamination problem is being corrected.

Unocal should not be responsible for mitigating groundwater contamination problems which are not attributable to its operations, and Unocal should not be responsible for preventing other party's contamination from migrating onto Unocal property.

I hope the above changes to the Consent Order Modification are acceptable to the Department. As always, I am available to discuss these issues at your convenience.
