This is to confirm that Mr. Herb Miller, a representative of the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), will be conducting a site visit on the morning of January 23, 1987. The trip has been coordinated with the Florida Department of Environmental Regulation (FDER), who may send a representative. This site visit will be used to develop a RCRA Facility Assessment (RFA) pursuant to Section 3004(u) of the 1984 Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments (HSWA) to RCRA.

The intent of the RFA is to develop a list of solid waste management units (SWMUs) which may exist at your facility and determine any additional data gathering which may be needed. This information will be used to evaluate the potential for releases of hazardous waste or hazardous constituents from any solid waste management units which may exist at your facility.
