

Re: Renewal of Used Oil Permit

Freehold Cartage, Inc., does not accept used oil directly from used oil generators. We operate a transfer station in Bartow, Fl where at this location we accept used oil from other transporters under the following conditions:

- 1. The transporter who accepted the used oil from the generator has performed a halogen screening test on each container of used oil being offered.
- 2. The results of the screening test are documented on the manifest/shipping papers.
- 3. The halogen levels are under 1,000 ppm.
- 4. Any used oil with an indicated halogen level greater than 1, 000 PPM is refused unless the used oil has been re-classed as a hazardous waste and manifested accordingly to a permitted Treatment, Storage, Disposal Facility.

BACKGROUND

Freehold Cartage Inc. (FCI) is located on approximately one and one half (1½) acres within the confines of the Bartow Municipal Airport. The address is 175 Bartow Municipal Airport, Bartow, Florida. Hours of operation are 6 AM to 8 PM, Monday through Saturday. Operations at the facility consist of activities associated with truck transportation operations as well as FDEP permitted transfer and temporary storage, incidental to transportation, of containerized hazardous and non-hazardous waste materials. All hazardous wastes at the facility are stored and/or transferred on an impervious surface secondary containment pad. The site discharges stormwater runoff thus is required to develop an SPPP and file a NOI with the Florida DEP. There are four employees on-site at most times during business hours. Additionally, there are approximately 25 Over-The-Road truck drivers who occasionally come through the site to pick up, or drop off trailers.

The facility has been covered under the MSGP since January of 2007.
