RE: Receipt of Completed Part A Application Pursuant to the Toxicity Characteristic (TC) Final Rule

Dear Mr. Busch:

The purpose of this letter is to acknowledge receipt of the revised Part A application submitted by Integrated Resource Recovery on February 6, 1991. This submittal completes your original application received on September 22, 1990.

Effective September 25, 1990, Integrated Resource Recovery has interim status to manage the TC wastes Numbered DO18 through DO43. Integrated Resource Recovery must submit a Part B Application when called upon to do so by EPA.

Interim status for TC wastes requires that Integrated Resource Recovery manage these wastes in compliance with all the applicable regulations in 40 CFR 265 until such time as a final decision is made on the completed hazardous waste permit application, which includes the Part B.
