

- 4. Description of Incident: After loading the bulk tanker, the hose was disconnected and the waste antifreeze spilled from the hose.
- 5. Extent of Personal Injuries: None



- 6. Extent of Property Damage: None
- 7. Description and Estimated Quantity of Material Released: Approximately 3-5 gallons of waste antifreeze.
- 8. Human Health and Environmental Impact: None
- 9. Remedial Action Taken: 3-5 gallons were recovered and returned to the tank. The absorbents were placed in a waste absorbent drum for disposal as hazardous waste.
- 10. Estimated Quantity of Clean-Up Reside for Treatment and Disposal: All liquid was returned to the tank. The absorbents will be shipped to New Church Energy Associates, Rte 709, New Church, Virginia 23415 for disposal.
