Receiving and processing a hazardous waste without a complete Authorization Request Form (ARF)

Dear Mr. Chapman:

On October 11, 1991, while conducting an on-site inspection the author learned that Safety Kleen (S.K.) had received eight drums of from three different generators for which there were no The author was informed by submitted prior to shipment. personnel that one drum of waste paint related material, having no prior ARF. was mistakenly processed. The remaining seven drums have been separated for shipment back to the generators.

S.K. must submit an explanation as The Department concluded that why the drums were shipped prior to completing the ARF's the corrective measures taken to prevent similar description of incidents from recurring. The requested information must be submitted to the author by November 1, 1991, for Departmental review.

Pending the review, the deficiency may be referred for appropriate Otherwise, if the deficiency continues the enforcement action. alternative but to pursue an enforcement Department may have no action.
