

Dear Mr. Fitzsimmons:

The purpose of this letter is to notify the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) of transportation paperwork discrepancies. These discrepancies, along with steps we are taking to prevent similar discrepancies from recurring are described below:

Safety-Kleen transported more than 220 pounds of hazardous waste in a calendar month from a customer without a EPA ID number (Tresca Industries - Feb 2, 1993 87 pounds and Feb 19, 1993 154 pounds).

The reason for this occurrence was that the services for two (2) machines not normally serviced in the same month came due in the same month. The machines are both on an eight (8) week service cycle, with the machines normally being serviced in opposite months. This schedule normally keeps the customer generation rate below 220 pounds per month. However, the customer requested an early service in December, 1992 that caused the next services to be performed in the same month.

The branch has been instructed to review the customer files for generator status and waste pickup in that month when called for early services. This review will ensure that waste pickups in a month do not exceed generator status requirements.
