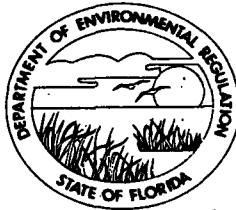

Dear Mr. Warren:

The Department understands your customers' concerns about shipping their hazardous wastes to a treatment/storage/disposal facility without a permit. Although Quadrex does not currently hold a hazardous waste permit, your newly regulated facility is allowed to operate pursuant to the terms of a bilateral Consent Order effective on April 9, 1987. We are currently processing your permit application submitted on July 8, 1987, in accordance with the Consent Order. This Order also requires your facility to comply with the hazardous waste regulations in Florida Administrative Code Chapter 17-30, which adopts and incorporates by reference 40 CFR 260-266. Compliance was verified during the July 14, 1987, EPA/DER inspection. The inspection report notes no violations of regulations and will be mailed to you within the next two weeks.
