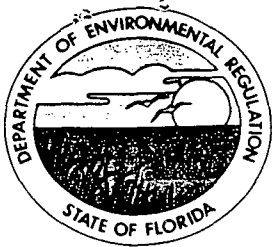

The Department has reviewed the Preliminary Contamination Assessment Plan (PCAP) for the referenced facility and has the following comments:

- 1) A brief site history, including the length of time the areas being assessed were used and how they were used, should be included.
- 2) Documents certifying that the laboratory performing the sampling and analysis has a Department approved Comprehensive Quality Assurance Plan (CompQAP).
3. Piezometers should be utilized to determine site specific groundwater flow directions and well locations for each area then be proposed to be downgradient of any potential release. Proposed well locations should take into affect the proximity of a tidally influenced water body.
4. Details of the construction and condition of the production wells on-site should be included in the Preliminary Contamination Assessment.
- 5) The well locations proposed for Area 7 appear to assume a northwesterly groundwater flow direction. While this flow direction is a strong possibility, it needs to be confirmed or additional wells proposed further to the northeast of Area 7.

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- 6) Based on the figure provided, two of the wells proposed appear to be in an upgradient position upgradient of the fuel tanks assuming groundwater flow direction is towards the St. Johns River. The majority of wells should be placed on the downgradient side of the potential release.
- 7) Groundwater samples should be collected from each of the monitoring wells and laboratory analysis for each sample collected be performed.
- 8) Soil and water samples should also be analyzed for total recoverable petroleum hydrocarbons (TRPH).


Responses to the above comments need to be included in the submittal of a revised PCAP within 14 days of receipt of this letter.
