NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE

THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (FDEP) GIVES NOTICE OF ITS INTENT TO ISSUE A PERMIT UNDER SECTION 403.722, FLORIDA STATUTES (F.S.) AND CHAPTERS 62- 4,62-730, AND 62-737, OF THE FLORIDA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE (F.A.C.) to Lighting Resources, LLC of Ocala with respect to the facility at 1007 SW 18th Lane, Ocala, Florida, having assigned facility I.D. number FLR 000 070 565.

The draft RCRA Permit modification contains the conditions for Operating Permit 0009099-HO-002. The Permit modification is intended to be issued to operate a mercury containing lamp and device storage and mercury recovery facility at Lighting Resources, LLC of Ocala, Florida.

Copies of the application and the draft Permit are available for public inspection during normal business hours 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except legal holidays, at FDEP, Central District Office, 3019 Maguire Blvd, Suite 232, Orlando, Florida 32803-3767, 407-897-4100 and at Division of Waste Management, Bureau of Solid & Hazardous Waste, Bob Martinez Center, 2600 Blair Stone Road, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400, (850) 245-9781. A person whose substantial interests are or will be affected by the intent to issue may petition for an administrative determination (hearing) under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. The petition must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in FDEP's Office of General Counsel, Agency Clerk, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station #35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-9000. Petitions filed by the permit applicant and any parties entitled to written notice under Section 120.60(3), F.S. must be filed within 45 days of receipt of the intent. Petitions filed by any other persons must be filed within 45 days of publication of this notice or receipt of the intent, whichever occurs first. A petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within this time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request a hearing under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. Any subsequent intervention (in a proceeding initiated by another party) will be only at the discretion of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-106.205, F.A.C.

A petition that disputes the material facts on which FDEP's action is based must contain the following information:

(a) The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner, the applicant's name and address, the FDEP Permit File Number and the county in which the project is proposed; (b) A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of FDEP's action or proposed action; (c) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interests are affected by FDEP's proposed action; (d) A statement of all material facts disputed by petitioner, or a statement that there are no disputed facts; (e) A statement of facts which petitioner contends warrant reversal or modification of FDEP's proposed action; (f) A statement of which rules or statutes the petitioner contends require reversal or modification of FDEP's proposed action; and (g) A statement of the relief sought by petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wants the Department to take with respect to the proposed action.

A petition that does not dispute the material facts on which FDEP's action is based shall state that no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-106.301, F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that FDEP's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice. Persons whose substantial interests will be affected by any such final decision of the FDEP have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding, in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

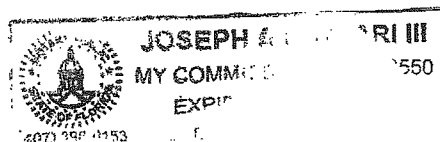
