Operation Description at Time of Inspection:

Laboratory analysis of various fuels perform by this business.

Inspector Comments: (Refer to the Violations Found on This Inspection page for violations cited, if any)

The laboratory receives samples of diesel, jet fuel, and #6 fuel oil for quality control analysis. A small portion of the sample is taken from a container and the remaining sample is kept on-site for 90 days in case of the need for confirmation analysis. The drums are inside the building in an area with a concrete berm on a plastic containment pallet

After 90 days the unused portions of the samples are placed into a drum. The drum contents are transferred into a vac-truck and shipped as non-hazardous waste by a licensed hauler. On occasion, a tiny portion of sample remains after analysis and that material is placed into a five gallon container. Another hauler is called to pick-up the five gallon container and at the same time takes the drums of unused samples and all the material is shipped as hazardous waste. Based on the hazardous material manifest the business is a Conditional Exempt Small Quantity Generator.

During review one manifest dated 12/20/2001 was noted for a pickup from a hauler using EPA ID# 984248278. All other manifest from February 2002 to present used EPA ID# FDL 980709075.

The lab manager was given two copies of Form 8700-12; one to closeout EPA ID# 984248278, and one to change the Generator Status of EPA ID# FDL 980709075 from SQG to CESQG. One set of instructions on how to complete the Form 8700-12 was given to the manager and the section showing where to send the signed form was reviewed.

VIOLATIONS FOUND ON THIS INSPECTION

As a result of this licensing inspection, EPD staff believe that a violation of the Broward County Natural Resources Protection Code (the Code) may have occurred. Violations Found During this Inspection

Description of Violation:

Based on the hazardous material manifest the business is a Conditional Exempt Small Quantity Generator, the Generator Status must to updated.

Corrective Action Required:

Use Form 8700-12 to change the Generator Status of EPA ID# FDL 980709075 from SQG to CESQG.
