Glenn:

Javier Garcia of EPA and Aaron Mitchell of FDEP conducted an EPA lead PCB/RCRA inspection at Florida Transformer in Defuniak Spring, Florida in December 2013. The inspectors observed PCB and RCRA violations during the inspection.

The main RCRA and PCB violations are:

- Failure to mark SAA containers
- Failure to date hazardous waste containers
- Failure to label hazardous waste containers in storage
- Storage of hazardous waste for longer than 90 days
- Failure to address hazardous waste management areas the contingency plan (The existing plan addresses PCBs)
- Failure to address hazardous waste management requirements in the training program (The existing program addresses PCBs)

We'll be taking the lead on Florida Transformer and will send out a Show Cause letter soon. We will keep you posted and cc you on all letters and e-mail going to the facilities.
