Compliance with Chapters 17-736 and 17-160, Florida Administrative Code

Our records show that your facility is undergoing a soil/ground water investigation or cleanup. Please be advised of two important new rules which may affect the compliance status of your facility, as outlined below.

1. Chapter 17-736, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), entitled "Warning Signs at Contaminated Sites" became effective on December 19, 1990. The intent of the rule is to protect the citizens of Florida from unknowingly becoming exposed to hazardous wastes and from entering sites which may have been contaminated by hazardous wastes.

2. Chapter 17-160, F.A.C., entitled "Quality Assurance" became effective on January 1, 1991. In 1983, the Department began a quality assurance program which was designed to assure that the biological and chemical data used by the Department was appropriate and scientifically sound. As the Department has grown, so has the potential for inconsistent application of the requirements. The purpose of this rule is to define those program areas requiring quality assurance approval or oversight; describe the procedures required to obtain quality assurance approval; and outline requirements for administrative procedures relating to quality assurance.

A copy of Chapter 17-736, F.A.C. is enclosed with this letter. Due to its length, Chapter 17-160, F.A.C. is available upon request. (Most firms performing site assessments, cleanups, or laboratory work should already be familiar with Chapter 17-160, F.A.C.)

Please review the enclosed Chapter 17-736, F.A.C. rule and if the rule applies to your facility, post and keep maintained the necessary warning signs. In addition, please make inquiries with your environmental consultant or laboratory in order to ensure compliance with the Quality Assurance rule. Also be advised that the Department is considering revisions to Chapter 17-730, F.A.C. governing hazardous waste management. As always, it is the responsibility of the facility owner/operator to keep appraised of any rule changes affecting compliance status. affecting compliance status.
