

Compliance Plus Services, Inc. ("CPS") is submitting this permit renewal request to the Department, on behalf of our client, American Transportation Solutions, Inc., for the renewal of the Hazardous Waste and Universal Waste Transporter Permit, specifically the Universal Permit which expires March 1, 2015. Please note that we are currently working with our insurance carrier on the completion of State of Florida Hazardous Waste Transporter Liability Endorsement Form No. 62-730.900(5)(b). Unfortunately, this Form is still in the process of being completed and will be submitted to the Department under separate cover. Along with the permit renewal request, note that ATS' mailing address (as indicated on the Form) has also changed to 310 Seven Fields Blvd, Suite 210, Seven Fields, PA.

We are also notifying the Department of a change in ownership and control of their permitted transportation fleet as a result of an acquisition of the Company by Clean Earth, Inc. Clean Earth is seeking to acquire the real property, equipment and operating permits of AES through a newly formed subsidiary, AES Asset Acquisition Corporation, d.b.a. American Transportation Solutions, LLC ("New ATS"). Pursuant to this transaction, we are providing the enclosed the Florida Notification of Regulated Waste Activity Form (8700-12FL) required to transfer ownership of ATS' existing Hazardous and Universal Waste Transporter Permit to the New ATS entity. Accordingly, we are requesting an expedited review of the information provided to allow this transaction to conclude.

This planned acquisition of the ATS operation by New ATS will not result in any changes to the existing operations. Additionally, no significant changes are planned related to current personnel and the existing operating team. Provided with this letter, as Exhibit I, is an insurance certificate listing the Florida Department of Environmental Protection as a certificate holder.
