Please see the attached strike-edit draft permit. I made the following changes:

- Page 2 restored Oxidation/Reduction treatment in containers in the summary (item #2J)
- Page 3 item #7 reverted to previous language describing debris wash process LSV processing is a separate process.
- Page 3 item #9, "Attachment A" changed to "Attachment G"
- Page 9 Condition 13b, included offsite document storage condition language from the previous permit (Old Part I condition 14, New Part I condition 13)
- Page 11 Condition 19, added language from previous permit exempting updating the permit list in Part I (Old Part I condition 8e, New Part I condition 19)
- Page 16 Part II.A.11.a, "maintained as the operating record" changed to "maintained in the operating record"
- Page 16 Part II.A.11.c, replaced list of responders with specific list from the previous permit (Old Part I 27.d, New Part II A.11.c). Unless there is a list of specific agencies where we are required to have coordination agreements, certain elements of the Perma-Fix customer base may interpret the condition in a broader sense than FDEP intends.
- Page 27 Part V.A1.b, "or other mean" changed to "or other means"

I also have a couple of questions/requests:

- Is it possible to have 60 days versus 30 in Part I condition 14 (was old Part I condition 15)
- Can insurance companies transmit financial assurance electronically based on Part I 26e?
- Does Part II.A.5.a mean we verify the profiles received from customers, or the profiles provided to generators? The second option would be a profile written in behalf of a generator, similar to services provided by a broker.
- Are groundwater requirements in Part I condition 11 (was old Part I condition 10) necessary in our situation?

We did also note that the drawings in the attachments are from the previous application, and we can send updated versions. I have also attached strike-edit and clean copy versions of the updated contingency plan information and container inspection log.
