## **Process Description:**

The Veolia Transfer Yard (Veolia) is used for the storage of facility transport trailers and is a registered Universal Waste Transfer Area.

Nine trailers were randomly inspected to ensure compliance with state and federal regulations. Trailers 818131 and 534332 were empty. Trailers 6921756, 622828, 653971, 683536, 889890, and 8000398 contained inbound Universal Waste. Trailer 818135 contained outbound Universal Waste. Trailer 8300249 was used for the storage of Georgia Power containers that were sent to the facility for the transport of their Universal Waste. Trailer 818133 was damaged and awaiting repairs.

The storage times vary depending on the content of the trailers. Trailers that have Universal Waste stored on them are kept in the transfer yard for a maximum of ten days. On the tenth day or previous to that day, the Universal Waste is off-loaded at the main facility's docking area for processing.
