The Hazardous Waste Compliance Assistance Program has concluded its case-specific classification review for Liquid Environmental Solutions. Based on our evaluation and discussion with you we concur with your recommendation the case specific violations do not justify a formal enforcement response even though some of the violations are repeats. The repeat label violation was for one small used oil container among several. Please add a comment in the inspection report for the repeat violations, if cited in future inspections, may trigger a formal enforcement response. Please let me know if you have any questions.
