FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION NOTICE OF INTENT TO ISSUE

THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION (FDEP) GIVES NOTICE OF ITS INTENT TO ISSUE A PERMIT UNDER SECTIONS 403.722, FLORIDA STATUTES (F.S.) AND CHAPTERS 62-4, 62-730, AND 62-737, OF THE FLORIDA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE (F.A.C.) TO Veolia ES Technical Solutions, L.L.C. of Tallahassee with respect to the facility at 342 Marpan Lane, Tallahassee, Florida having assigned facility ID number FL000207449.

The draft PERM contains the conditions for Operating Permit 9071915 WD-013. The Permit is intended to be used to operate a mercury containing lamp and device storage and mercury recovery and reclamation facility at Veolia ES Technical Solutions, L.L.C. of Tallahassee, Florida.

Copies of the application and the draft Permit are available for public inspection during normal business hours 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., Monday through Friday, except legal holidays, at FDEP, Pensacola District Office, 440 West Government Street, Suite 104, Pensacola, Florida 32502-5740; 850-595-8900 and at Division of Waste Management, Permitting and Compliance Assistance Program Bob Martinez Center, 3600 Blue Stone Road, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400, (850) 245-8781. Electronic copies of the application and draft permit can be accessed in <http://dwdemms.dep.state.fl.us/OCulists/tenlistopen>.

A person whose substantial interests are or will be affected by the intent to issue this permit for an Administrative Determination (hereinafter referred to as "AD") under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. The person must contain the information set forth below and must be filed (received) in FDEP's Office of General Counsel, Agency Clerk, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, Mail Station 375 Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000. Persons who file the permit application and any parties entitled to written notice under Section 120.60(2), F.S. must be filed within 45 days of receipt of the intent.

Persons filed by any other persons must be filed within 45 days of publication of this notice or receipt of the intent, whichever occurs first.

A petitioner shall mail a copy of the petition to the applicant at the address indicated above at the time of filing. The failure of any person to file a petition within this time period shall constitute a waiver of that person's right to request a hearing under Sections 120.569 and 120.57, F.S. Any subsequent intervention (in a proceeding initiated by another party) will be only at the discretion of the presiding officer upon the filing of a motion in compliance with Rule 28-105.205, F.A.C.

A petition that disputes the material facts on which FDEP's action is based must contain the following information:

(a) The name, address, and telephone number of each petitioner, the applicant's name and address, the FDEP Permit File Number and the county in which the project is proposed; (b) A statement of how and when each petitioner received notice of FDEP's action or proposed action; (c) A statement of how each petitioner's substantial interest is affected by FDEP's proposed action; (d) A statement of all material facts disputed by petitioner; or a statement that there are no disputed facts; (e) A statement of facts which petitioner contends warrants reversal or modification of FDEP's proposed action; and (f) A statement of the relief sought by petitioner, stating precisely the action petitioner wants the Department to take with respect to the proposed action.

A petition that does not dispute the material facts on which FDEP's action is based shall state the no such facts are in dispute and otherwise shall contain the same information as set forth above, as required by Rule 28-105.20, F.A.C.

Because the administrative hearing process is designed to formulate final agency action, the filing of a petition means that FDEP's final action may be different from the position taken by it in this notice. Persons whose substantial interest will be affected by any such final decision of the FDEP have the right to petition to become a party to the proceeding in accordance with the requirements set forth above.

Any person may request a public meeting regarding the proposed permit being decision pursuant to Section 403.722 (10), F.S. A request for public meeting is not equivalent to a request for a formal or informal administrative hearing. Public meetings are not evidentiary in nature, and information submitted at a public meeting is for non-binding consideration only. A public meeting is still subject to court or appellate review. A request for a public meeting must be filed (received) in the Office of General Counsel, Agency Clerk, within 45 days of publication of this notice. Failure to file a request for a public meeting within this time period shall constitute a waiver of any right such a person may have to request a meeting under Section 403.722 (10), F.S.

Verification is not available in this proceeding.
