Introduction:

Crowley Liner Services, Inc. (Crowley), located at 3001 Talleyrand Avenue, was inspected by the Department's Hazardous Waste Program on April 27, 2017. A second Crowley-owned facility, located at 1163 Talleyrand Avenue (FLD 085 092 146), was also inspected on April 27, 2017, and that inspection report will be issued under separate correspondence. This Crowley facility at 3001 Talleyrand Avenue is leased to Crowley by the Jacksonville Port Authority (JPA) who owns the property. The Department's Hazardous Waste Program last inspected both facilities on September 12, 2013. This facility at 3001 Talleyrand Avenue has been issued the EPA/DEP identification number FLD 000 054 221. Please use this number on all hazardous waste related correspondence with the Department.

Crowley is a transporter of hazardous materials and waste through its ocean-going barge and intermodal fleet transport operations. Crowley transports hazardous material/waste and other cargo between Puerto Rico, the US Virgin Islands, other Caribbean ports, and Jacksonville via triple-decked barges. Crowley currently uses the 1163 Talleyrand Avenue site to load and unload barges.

Process Description:

This site is being renovated by Crowley so it can relocate operations from 1163 Talleyrand Avenue (FLD 085 092 146) and consolidate all shipping operations at this one location. Crowley is discontinuing use of its current cargo barges and will be using a different type of vessel when it moves to this location. At the time of the inspection, Crowley was using this site to store empty cargo containers, pending future use or refurbishment, and a minor amount of out-bound cargo containers. No hazardous waste was being accumulated or generated at this location at the time of the inspection.

Records Review

No hazardous waste had been accumulated on site during the previous three years so no inspection logs or manifests were reviewed. The site's Emergency Contingency Plan, currently maintained by JPA, was reviewed and appeared to be in order. Training certificates, Transporter registration and financial responsibility certification, were reviewed and appeared to be in order. Portions of the western security fence, maintained by JPA, and signage on the fence were inspected. The security fence was in good repair and adequate signage was posted on the fence surrounding the facility.


