Dear Mr. Gonzalez:

This letter is in response to your letter dated May 7, 1999 regarding notification of non-compliance with respect to 17 drums of transfer waste.

The Department concurs, that as stated in your letter, that the transportation of the drums in question back to the generators may pose additional unnecessary risk to the public. Therefore, under the present circumstances, it would seem prudent for the Department to allow the drums in question to remain in storage at the permitted storage facility until June 1, 1999, when the drums are scheduled to be manifested to Waste Technologies Industries (WTI), with the following conditions:

In addition, at the time the 17 drums are manifested off to WTI, (June 1, 1999) a copy of the manifest will be faxed to the Department to confirm the date of shipment.

To prevent a similar occurrence in the future the facility must submit a corrective action plan to address the non-compliance issues by, but not limited to, one or more of the following:

- 1. Submitting a permit modification to add the waste codes in question to the permitted storage facility.
- 2. Notifying the generators of this waste, that an alternate facility must be designated in the event that the primary facility can no longer accept the waste in a timely manner.
- 3. Initiating a policy whereby waste codes that are not permitted to be stored at the permitted storage facility, such as KO44, KO45, PO42 and PO81, are not accepted.

This letter does not preclude enforcement actions for other non-compliance issues that may arise from the storage of these 17 drums of transfer waste at your facility.
