Orange County – HW Chemical Conservation Corporation Biennial Waste Report Status

Dear Mr. Gonzalez:

The Department received the waste report submitted as a requirement of the 1998 Consent Order, OGC number 98-2611. The purpose of this submittal is to work out any problems in the reporting process prior to March 1, 2000, when the next Biennial Report must be submitted to the Department.

The report, in its current state, appears to be improperly formatted and incomplete. The following items were noted during a review of the data submitted:

- Pages are randomly numbered or out of order in all files
- No on-site treatment codes in the Form WR data
- Invalid waste codes in the Form GM and WR data
- Form OI unusable due to bad formatting and missing information
- Never more than one waste code per waste stream
- In Form GM, the G1 file was incorrectly laid out with TAB characters instead of spaces and incorrect record lengths and number formats
- In Form GM, the G2 file was incorrectly laid out and inaccurate
- In Form GM, all files were incorrectly named
- In Form WR, W1 file, the ID numbers of the sending generators were missing and the format of the file was invalid
- No signed Form IC accompanied the report
