





Dear Mr. Sullivan:

Your submission of the <u>1997 Biennial Hazardous Waste Report</u> to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP), was required to be submitted by March 30, 1998. The Department has received three separate incomplete, badly formatted, and essentially unusable electronic submissions. These problems were discussed on several occasions by telephone with Rick Brown of your corporate offices, who then re-submitted incorrect data following each of these conversations.

This letter is to notify you that the FDEP has not received a usable Biennial Hazardous Waste report as of June 10, 1998.

A correct re-submission must be postmarked or hand delivered to our office by the 15th working day after your receipt of this letter. You may seek an extension of time to submit your report, but the request must be made before the end of the 15 day period. Except in extraordinary circumstances, however, no extension will be made. EPA and FDEP consider this report to be an important and integral part of the RCRA compliance process, and failure to submit this data correctly may be reviewed for enforcement action.
